**Millennium Hotel Cincinnati, Ohio**

The hotel is located across the street from the Duke Energy Convention Center and is joined by the Skywalk link. It sits approximately 12 miles from the Cincinnati Northern Kentucky Airport (airport code is CVG).

There is a restaurant in the Millennium Hotel that has American food and is reasonably priced, you can see the menu for “Bistro on Elm” on the hotel web site ([www.millenniumhotels.com](http://www.millenniumhotels.com)). Also, within walking distance (approximately 2 blocks) is Tower Place Mall’s Food Court where you will find Chick-Fil-A, Great Steak and Potato Co, Sbarro, and Gold Star Chili, among others.

**Other costs and information**

- Baggage tips at airport and hotel (\$1 per bag based on 2 bags) \$ 8.00
- Remember Baggage Fee that some airlines charge 25.00
- Taxi Cab information –  
One way, between the airport and the hotel, for up to 4 people. 26.00 + tip
- Shuttle from airport  
The Executive Transportation Shuttle is \$20 one way per person, \$30 roundtrip.
- Hotel Parking  
Valet parking ONLY at \$22 per day with in/out privileges
- Duke Energy Center Parking (overnight parking is NOT permitted)  
There are several parking lots or parking garages located around the Duke Energy Convention Center for daily parking. A few have evening and weekend \$ specials. You may contact the parking systems at the numbers below for prices.
