- In Support of Increased Awareness of Parental Education Methods Related to the Prevention of Childhood Obesity

Community Health Project Awards

Disaster Preparedness Awards

- Award focuses on how a state or school raises awareness of its disaster plan, or develops plans for disaster response at the school, local, state, or national level.
